Project Benefits

- **Relieve flooding** in residential and commercial areas of Southeast Seminole Heights
- **Improve wet-weather driving conditions** along hurricane evacuation routes
- **Enhance safety** for vehicles, pedestrians and bicycles along Central Avenue
- **Improve fire protection** for homes and businesses

Construction will begin simultaneously at:

- the Hillsborough River outfall
- Crest Avenue
- Caracas Street and Taliaferro Avenue
- Central Avenue between Giddens and Caracas avenues
